- 1 *Heidsieck Brut Champagne - £26.00*  
Fresh and dry, revealing elegant perfumes and fine bubbles. Perfect both as an apéritif and throughout the meal
- 2 *Oeil de Perdrix Rosé Champagne - £30.00*  
Delicate in style, but with a perfect weight of fruit
- 3 *Lanson Black Label Champagne - £34.00*  
Well structured, lively Champagne that demonstrates a powerful edge that softens with bottle age
- 4 *Mumm Cordon Rouge Champagne NV- £35.00*  
Ever popular Champagne from a great house that delivers top quality at a good price
- 5 *Veuve Clicquot Champagne - £40.00*  
Superb marriage of freshness and power; with a rich dry fruity flavour

- 6 *Cava Cristalino Reserva Spain- £15.00*  
This traditional Cava is well balanced with fresh fruits and a distinctive nutty twang
- 7 *Codorniu Cuvée Raventos Spain - £15.00*  
This prestigious Spanish Cava boasts rich, creamy flavours in an elegant style

- 8 *McGuigan Estate Sparkling Pinot Noir/Chardonnay Brut Australia - £15.00*  
Light and delicate on the nose, with strawberry and lemon flavours. Crisp and clean, it is an ideal apéritif
- 9 *Lindauer Brut New Zealand - £15.00*  
Consistently one of the most sought-after sparkling wines in the world

## FRENCH WHITE

10 *Muscadet Sur Lie Loire Valley 2005 - £13.00*

A tangy, refreshing Muscadet which has acquired a spritzy, yeasty and fuller taste through a period of maturation on its lees

11 *Chablis, Cave de Chablis Burgundy 2005 - £14.00*

A steely, minerally and flinty Chablis, that is elegant and refined

12 *Sancerre, Roger Neveu Loire Valley 2005 - £15.50*

Beautifully balanced and supremely refined with grassy aromatic fruit character and a lively, tangy finish

13 *Meursault, Henri de Villamont Burgundy 2004 - £21.00*

Offers rich buttery fruit, a fine unctuous palate and a soft nutty finish. This proves why Meursault is hailed as one of the better names in Burgundy vineyards

## FRENCH RED

14 *La Rectorie, Côtes du Rhône Villages Rhône Valley 2004 - £13.00*

Deep red in colour, this wine has intense aromas of red berry fruits, violets and peppers. The palate is full-bodied and spicy with fine tannins and a smooth finish

15 *Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Louis Latour Burgundy 2005 - £13.50*

With plenty of soft ripe raspberry fruit, this is a great example of why Burgundy reds are famed for their finesse, elegance and charm

16 *Fleurie Flower Label, Georges Duboeuf Beaujolais 2005 - £14.00*

The epitome of a Beaujolais Cru. Fruity, scented with an attractive silky texture and fresh raspberry fruit from Mr Beaujolais himself

17 *Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Domaine Lucien Barrot Rhône Valley 2003 - £21.00*

This is a powerful, yet softly structured Châteauneuf. Juicy blackcurrant and blueberry flavours fill the mouth while aromas of leather, smoke and Asian spices fill the nose.

18 *La Réserve de Léoville-Barton, St Julien Bordeaux 2000 - £35.00*

The second wine of Château Leoville-Barton. Grapes are hand-picked and fermented in large oak vats before undergoing 15 months ageing in oak barrels. The subsequent wine is concentrated but elegant, with ripe fruits and delicate perfume – a claret of true class

## ITALIAN WHITE

19 *Bianco di Sicilia, Cantine Settesoli Sicily 2005 - £13.00*

Made from local Sicilian grape varieties, this great wine is light bodied yet full of ripe fresh fruit flavour. A crisp fresh finish completes the package

20 *Pinot Grigio, Pasqua Veneto 2005 - £15.50*

Fruity and aromatic, this deliciously crisp, light and zingy wine shows refreshing apricot fruit flavours

21 *Gavi di Gavi Raccolto Tardivo, Villa Lanata 2005 - £14.00*

Made from the Italian Cortese grape, this ripe, crisp fulsome white is harvested late in the season to give even more grapefruit & apricot intensity, with refined strength

## ITALIAN RED

22 *Rosso di Sicilia, Cantine Settesoli Sicily 2005 - £13.00*

A warm, rich aroma, followed by classic Italian morello cherry flavours and a light fresh finish

23 *Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Moncaro 2005 - £15.00*

A rich, cherry-flavoured wine that fully reflects the excellent vineyard sites Moncaro have in the Marche region

24 *Valpolicella Classico Superiore, Veneti, Negrar 2004 - £15.50*

A richly cherried wine with a smooth marzipan finish. A wonderful step above your average Valpolicella

25 *Barolo La Mora 2002 - £24.00*

A deliciously mature Barolo offering raisin and plum fruit aromas. Well-structured with good acidity and length

## SPANISH WHITE

26 *Marques de Caceres Rioja Blanco 2005 - £13.00*

A superb white Rioja in the modern style with a complex and distinctive full flavour, dry and slightly nutty. Floral hints on the nose belie the touch of honey on the palate

## SPANISH RED

27 *Castillo Rioja, Bodegas Palacio 2004 - £13.50*

An excellent wine from a great producer. Distinct flavours are combined with an abundance of fruit balanced with velvety smooth tannins

28 *Rioja Crianza, Marqués de Càceres 2002 - £14.00*

This full-bodied, spicy Rioja is aged in American/French oak for 6 months imparting hints of cinnamon and vanilla

29 *Marqués de Riscal Reserva Rioja 2001 - £18.00*

A fantastic Rioja Reserva showing classic aromas of vanilla and toasted oak combined with summer fruits. Marques de Riscal is the master

### *NEW WORLD WHITE*

30 *Neblina Sauvignon Central Valley, Chile 2005 - £13.00*

Youthful, lively and fresh, this Sauvignon Blanc has herbal tropical notes on the nose, followed by a zesty citrus palate

31 *Griffin Vineyards Chardonnay South Eastern, Australia 2004 - £14.50*

A crisp, fresh style of Chardonnay which displays hints of butterscotch on the palate coupled with delicious banana and mango fruit flavours

32 *Southbank Estate Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough New Zealand 2005 - £13.50*

Displaying ripe gooseberries followed by crisp, clean acidity and a refreshing finish that are the hallmark of this unmistakable Marlborough Sauvignon

33 *Montes Alpha Chardonnay Casablanca Valley, Chile 2005 - £16.50*

A rich buttery Chardonnay from one of the best producers in Chile. Aromas of toffee apple with lovely essences of toasty oak make this a great alternative to white burgundy

### *NEW WORLD RED*

34 *Neblina Merlot Central Valley, Chile 2007 - £13.00*

On the nose rich notes of plum and blackberries lifted by chocolate and mocha. Silky yet structured with concentrated fruit flavours

35 *Spier Shiraz Western Cape, South Africa 2004 - £13.50*

Deep crimson-red in colour and an inviting nose of plums, white pepper and ginger precedes a mouth-filling, lively palate. Classic New World Shiraz

36 *Montes Alpha Cabernet Sauvignon Curico Valley, Chile 2004 - £14.50*

This rich, fruity blackcurrant Cabernet Sauvignon has been aged in French oak for 12 months prior to bottling. Located in the heart of the Curico Valley, Montes Alpha produce superb wines that can be said to rival many Medoc estates

37 *Yering Station Pinot Noir Yarra Valley, Australia 2003 - £18.00*

Black cherry and plum aromas, hints of spice and an intense full and rich palate make this a wine of true class

## CALIFORNIAN WHITE

38 *Gravel Bed Vineyards Chardonnay Lodi 2005 - £13.00*

Pale straw in colour, delicious tropical fruit flavours of lime, pineapple and mango are complimented by a hint of creamy oak

49 *Beringer Appellation Collection Fumé Blanc Napa Valley 2003 - £14.00*

Sauvignon Blanc the Californian way, toasted oak nose with aromas of citrus fruits, ripe melon with bold hints of butterscotch

## CALIFORNIAN RED

40 *Gravel Bed Vineyards Zinfandel 2005 - £13.00*

Deeply coloured and showing intense aromas of fresh blueberries and raspberries, with a touch of cinnamon. Plenty of classic pepper spiciness adds character to this rich, balanced wine

41 *Beringer Appellation Collection Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley 1999 - £19.50*

Classic Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon from the magnificent Beringer winery, founded by Joseph Beringer in 1976. Intense herb, blackcurrant and liquorice aroma

## ROSÉ WINES

42 *Rosé d'Anjou, La Jaglerie Vin de Pays d'Oc 2005 - £13.00*

A medium dry rosé with pronounced aromas of red fruit with flowery hints. The appealing palate is fresh and well balanced with ample, rich ripe fruit

43 *Neblina Merlot Rosé Central Valley, Chile 2007 - £13.50*

An exciting New World Rosé packed with intense colour and mouthwatering red fruit characters

44 *Château Saint Roch-lès-Vignes, Rosé Provence, France 2004 - £13.50*

A delicious rosé showing soft spice and attractive fruit from this top winery in St. Tropez. Its luxurious origins are proven in the tasting

45 *Yering Station Pinot Noir Rosé Yarra Valley, Australia 2004 - £14.00*

Aromas of red berry fruit, dark cherry and kirsch, are joined by complex Cedar, savoury spice and toasted nut characters. Raspberries and red currants develop on the full, rounded palate, giving a long finish

Medium-bodied with ripe plum and berry aromas from the start, a great party wine
